

Specialty Care Coordination


There were **412 eConsults** that were resolved without the need for a face-to-face visit with the specialist.

This month, **Plastic Surgery** resolved the most eConsults without the need for a face-to-face specialty visit.


You and other MCel specialist reviewers coordinated with primary care providers across **94 clinics** in the Inland Empire via eConsult.

There have been a total of 86,056 eConsults since the program's start date.


