
ARMC CARE COORDINATION

There were **48 eConsults** that were resolved without the need for a face-to-face specialist visit.


This month, **Wound Care** resolved the highest percent of eConsults without the need for a face-to-face specialty visit.

- There are 7 ARMC and SBCSD primary care clinics.
 - 1,604 eConsults were submitted in December.
 - 42,761 eConsults were submitted since the program's start.
- Combined, there are 153 clinics from ARMC, Riverside University Health System (RUHS) and Inland Empire Health Plan (IEHP).
 - 155,553 eConsults since the start of the Specialty Care Access Program.

There have been a total of 155,553 eConsults since the program's start date.
